



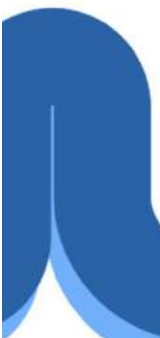

- 3- Hostel mess facility (For hostelites)

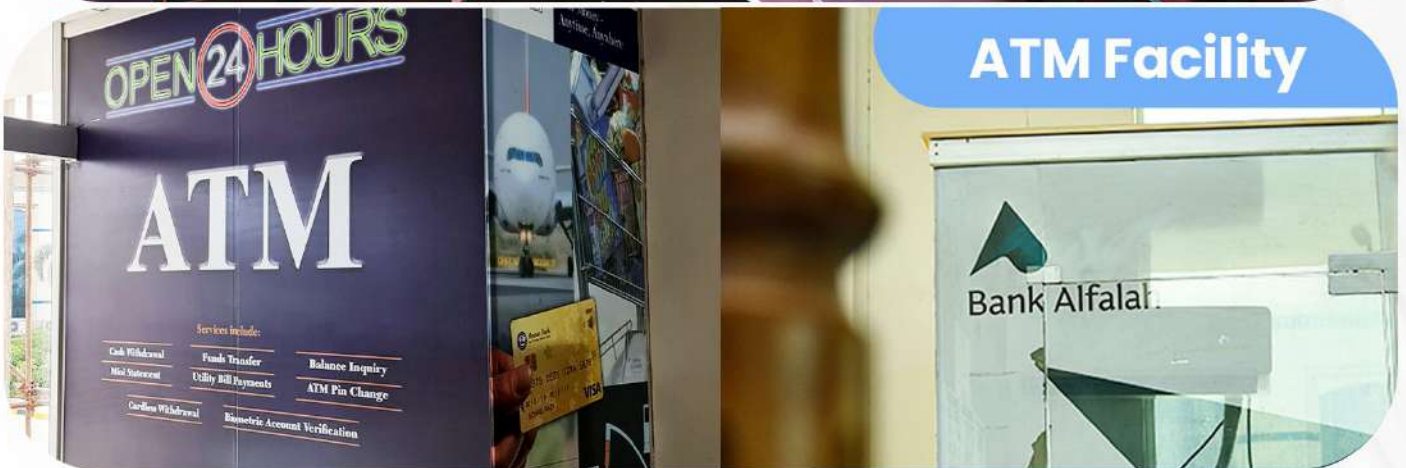

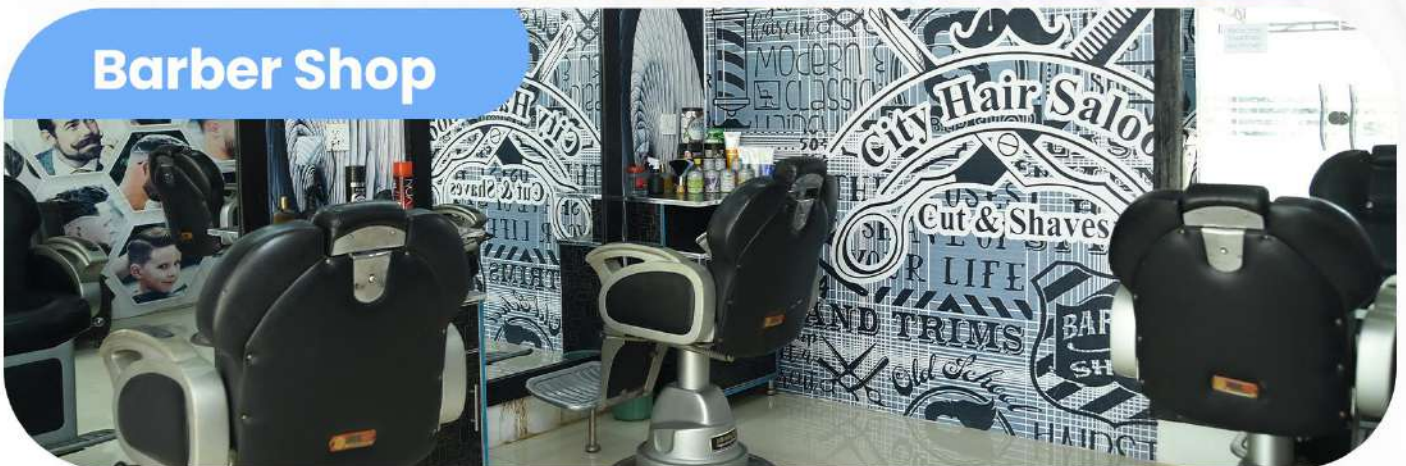

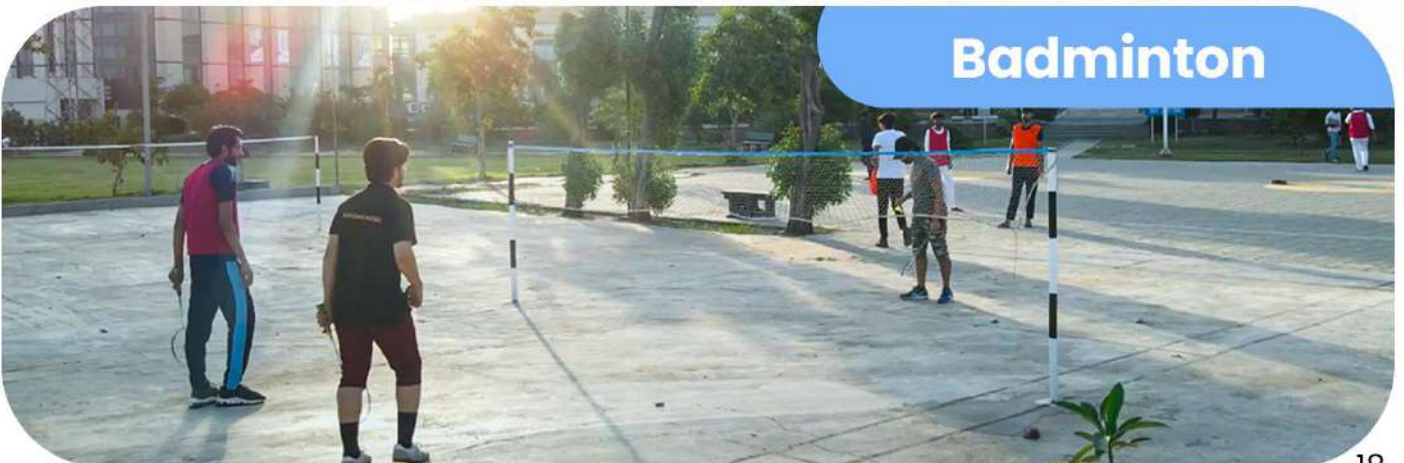

HOSTEL FACILITIES



ABOUT HOSTEL

FAST NUCES Chiniot Faisalabad is the first fully residential campus of FAST NUCES. It provides secure & well-managed hostel facilities for both male and female students, accommodating around 1000 residents. The campus offers separate & well-structured residential arrangements for boys and girls to ensure a safe, comfortable, and disciplined living environment. The boys' hostel consists of three buildings, including Iqbal Hall and Jinnah Hall, with a total capacity of approximately 750 students, while the girls' hostel is a separate, dedicated, and fully secure residential block with a capacity of around 250 students. Both hostels are designed to facilitate students coming from different cities (other than district Faisalabad), ensuring convenience and easy access to on-campus living while maintaining appropriate segregation and security standards.

In both boys' and girls' hostels, furnished rooms are provided to meet the academic and residential needs of students. Each room is equipped with essential furniture such as beds, study tables, chairs, and cupboards, ensuring a comfortable and organized environment that supports both study and rest.

Mess facilities are available in both boys' and girls' hostels, offering nutritious and hygienic meals three times a day. The student mess hall is designed to efficiently accommodate its respective hostel residents, ensuring a well-managed dining environment and promoting healthy eating habits among students. Other than the hostel mess, the students may opt to eat at the university cafeteria and dhaba.

A fully functional medical facility is available for both male and female students through the medical center. This facility provides timely healthcare services, addressing routine medical needs as well as emergencies, thereby ensuring the well-being and safety of all hostel residents.

For physical fitness and well-being, a fully equipped gymnasium is provided within the hostel. The gym contains modern exercise machines and fitness equipment that support various forms of physical training, encouraging students to maintain an active and healthy lifestyle.

Both male and female hostels include a separate prayer room. In addition, hostels have well-maintained grounds and sports facilities after university hours. These facilities support a wide range of outdoor games and physical activities, promoting teamwork, discipline, and overall physical fitness among students while contributing to a balanced campus life.

Overall, the hostel facilities at FAST NUCES Chiniot Faisalabad are purpose-built to provide a secure, comfortable, and well-equipped residential environment for both male and female students. These arrangements not only support academic success but also promote health, discipline, and a balanced campus lifestyle.

FAQs ABOUT HOSTELS

How Can I Reach The Hostel?

A pick-and-drop facility is available for hostel residents. Pickup and drop-off services are provided according to the notified schedule.

What Is The Procedure For A Hostel Student If He/She Wants To Go For Shopping?

Twice a week, shuttle service will be provided for male students to go to Faisalabad for shopping, and once a week for female students to go to Faisalabad for shopping. However, the number of trips in a semester for each student is limited to 6. Moreover, transportation shall be provided subject to the availability of a bus and driver.

If A Student Wants To Go Out From Campus, Then What's The Procedure?

The student shall apply for a gate pass. He/She will visit the relevant office, & the authorized representative at the designated place shall verify it with his/her parent/guardian and approve or reject the gate pass.

Are Outsiders Allowed To Stay At Hostel?

Outsiders are not allowed to stay or enter the hostel premises. However, parents or legal guardians of the concerned student may visit the hostel during the designated visiting hours. To ensure the privacy & comfort of all residents, parents/guardians are not permitted to enter or visit students' rooms.

What Kind Of Food Is Provided At Hostel Mess?

Optional food is provided three times a day for students who choose to avail the facility. However, students can bring food from home in a storage box, which may be consumed within two weeks. Each resident is allowed one food storage container with a maximum size of approximately 6 in × 6 in × 6 in (Length × Width × Height).

What Is The Security Fee For New Students?

For new students, a one-time security fee of **Rs. 22,000/-** is applicable.

What Does The Hostel Fee Include?

The hostel fee does not include mess expenses. Facilities such as shuttle service & electricity are included. However, students opting for air-conditioners will be charged separately based on electricity consumption.

Who Is Responsible For The Installation And Electricity Charges Of An Air-Conditioner?

The installation of the air-conditioner in the room & the division/payment of the electricity bill shall be the sole responsibility of the students.

What Are The Charges For An Air Cooler?

Air cooler charges are fixed at **Rs. 3,000/-** per month.

FAQs ABOUT HOSTELS

Are Single- And Double-Occupancy Rooms Available For All Students?

As per policy, single- and double-occupancy rooms are reserved exclusively for graduating batches with top CGPAs or for students with valid medical reasons. This medical reason shall be valid after the endorsement of the Medical Officer, the Hall Management Committee, & approval from the competent authority. The new batch will be accommodated in shared rooms.

How Can I Join The Gym Facility At Hostels?

Students may avail the hostel gym facility by paying a maintenance fee of **Rs. 5,000** per semester or **Rs. 2,000** per month, along with a one-time registration fee of **Rs. 1,000**.

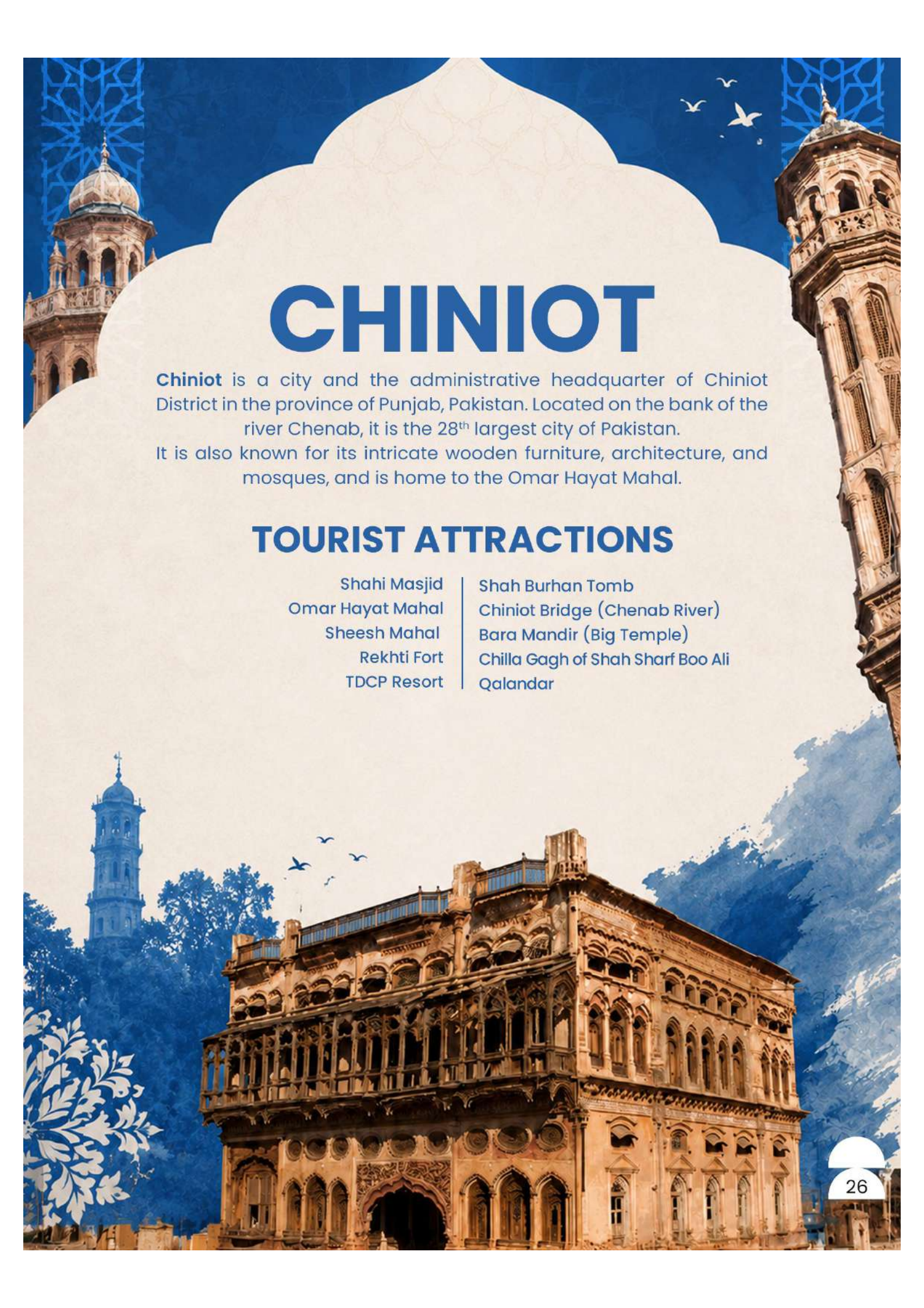

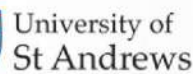
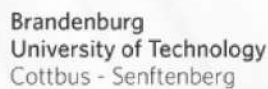
